Eligibility Requirements:

- > NAHAM Membership is voluntary, not required for the exam
- One (1) year of practical experience in healthcare or finance industry OR successful completion of an accredited college program in healthcare
- High school diploma or GED equivalent PLUS 30 professional development contact hours earned within the previous two (2) years; OR an associate degree from an accredited institution
- > Signature of one (1) supervisor or course instructor/advisor
- Completed application with exam fee
- Maintain current membership with the AAPC; Renewing members must have a current membership at the time of application submission as well as when results are sent.
