



Pharmacy Technician Externship Price Sheet

This 80 hour unpaid externship is offered to give students hands-on experience in the field. Students must pass the course and submit all the necessary documentation.

Cost to participate in Externship: \$299*

Student Eligibility Requirements:

**Note: Students are responsible for all fees associated with the following externship eligibility requirements*

- Complete immunization record (including Hepatitis B series and updated Tetanus)
 - Students may opt out of the Hep. B vaccinations if they sign a waiver.
- Proof of a negative PPD test (TB test) within the last 12 months
- Letter from health care provider stating student is free of all communicable diseases and cleared to participate in an externship.
- Negative 9 panel drug screen
- FBI National Background Check

 - Cost for application is only \$18.

The state of Arizona requires pharmacy technicians to be registered with the State and licensed before beginning work in a pharmacy. Candidates must pay to apply (\$46) for licensure. To register, please visit the following website:
